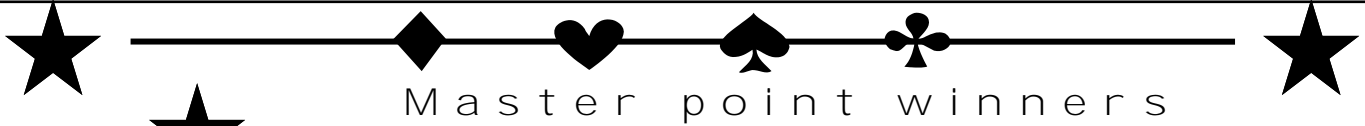

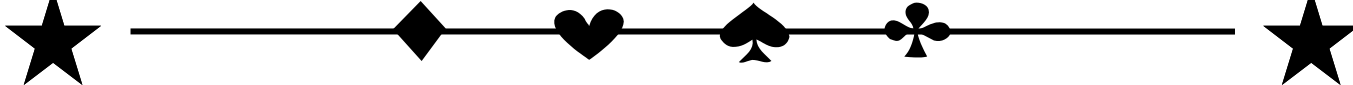

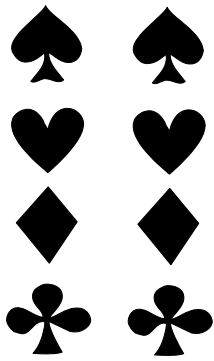
Club Championship

Rules Corner

Opening Lead out of Turn
Call The Director for these 5 options
As Declarer

1. You may accept the lead from the wrong hand and see dummy before playing from your own hand.
2. You may accept the lead and become dummy.
3. You may require the lead from the proper leader.
4. You may prohibit the lead—from the proper leader for as long as he holds the lead—of the suit that was improperly led, and the penalty card is returned to offenders hand.
5. You may leave the improperly led card on the table to remain as a penalty card. The opening leader can lead as he chooses. If the correct opening leader retains or regains the lead and his partner still has the penalty card, you will, each time before the defender leads, have the choice of exercising option 3, 4 or 5.
