Tucson, AZ -- ACBL Unit 356 congratulates The Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs and Mini-McKenney winners for 2016. Awards will be presented before play at the Sunday, April 2 unit game held at Adobe Bridge Club, 401 E. Limberlost, Tucson.

The Helen Shanbrom Ace of Clubs winners will be honored with a certificate for the most wins in club games during 2016 within their respective point count category. Black points are counted and not points earned in STaCs and other special games paying pigmented points.

In 2011, the Ace of Clubs award was named after Helen Shanbrom, the most successful club player in ACBL history. Helen passed in 2013 at the age of 94.

SQUEEZED IN 3 SUITS

♠ A954 ♥ QJT ♦ J5 ♣ AJT2	Both Vulnerable <i>South West North East</i> 1♦ Dbl Pass 2NT Pass 3NT Pass Pass Pass

<i>Declarer</i>	3NT is an optimistic contract, but things get better when West leads the Heart Three to East's Ace. East returns the Heart Four at Trick 2.
♠ Q63 ♥ K2 ♦ A986 ♣ Q963	What inferences can you draw from the play so far?

There are 16 combined HCP in the E-W hands, and East has shown up with the ♥A. As West opened the bidding West no doubt has the remaining 12 HCP (well, he might be missing the ♠J, we suppose).

The good news is that the Club finesse is working and that takes your trick total to 8 ... the bad news is that the ♠K is sitting over your Queen, so there is no obvious way to score a 9th trick. It looks like some kind of end-play or squeeze will be required, in which case it will help to work out West's distribution. Playing on Clubs will shed some light, so (after winning that Heart on the second trick) you run the Club Nine, which holds. On the third round of Clubs West shows out. What is his distribution?

Not five Diamonds (West didn't lead one), nor three Diamonds (East didn't raise), so assume four Diamonds. How many Hearts? West would have led top-of-nothing with three (also, East might have bid 1♥ with five), so assume West has four Hearts. That means West started with 3=4=4=2 distribution and the hand is an open book:

What does West pitch on the third Club?

- If West pitches a Spade then you cash the ♠A and duck a Spade to West's King, scoring the 9th trick with the ♠Q
- If West pitches a Heart then you cash the ♥Q and run the ♦J around to West (now West must play on Diamonds or Spades, either of which gives up the 9th trick)
- If West pitches a Diamond then you run the ♦J around to West's Queen and have the timing to set up the 13th Diamond.

Poor West was squeezed in three suits, but it required accurate card reading to take advantage of that. It also required that Declarer played the Clubs just right, running the Nine first, and leading a low Club from hand on the second round. That way he was able to win the third Club on the board (in case West pitched a Heart and Dummy's ♥Q needed to be cashed), and keep the fourth Club as an entry to hand (in case West pitched a Diamond).
